The California community college courses listed below will satisfy the California State University (CSU) graduation requirements in American Institutions.

Students satisfy this CSU graduation requirement through coursework in three areas:

- US-1: Historical development of American institutions and ideals
- US-2: United States Constitution and government
- US-3: California state and local government

#### Conditions

- This requirement may be met before or after transfer to the CSU.
- Any community college may certify completion by students who take courses approved in the three areas, as published here.
- Students who want to fulfill this requirement with courses taken before Fall 2004 should consult their college catalogs.
- If a course is approved for more than one US Area below, a student may use the course to satisfy all areas listed.
- US-1 may be completed with a score of 3 or higher on Advanced Placement US History.
- US-2 (but not US-3) may be completed with a score of 3 or higher on Advanced Placement US Government and Politics.
- At the discretion of the CSU campus granting the degree, courses meeting this requirement may also be counted toward certification in general education (CSU GE-Breadth or IGETC).
